



PhD Scholarships for the study of the biological bases of Autism.

Six scholarships are offered through a new program of Swinburne University: Swinburne Autism Bio-Research Initiative (SABRI). SABRI aims to be the preeminent research group in the southern hemisphere devoted to the study of the biological foundations of Autism.

Applications are invited from all relevant disciplines for projects that relate to one or more of the following broad areas and their association with Autism:-

- **Toxicology**
- **Biochemistry**
- **Endocrinology**
- **Immunology**
- **Microbiology**
- **Neurology**

Applicants may be from any relevant discipline (e.g., psychophysiology, biomedicine, environmental science, toxicology, biochemistry etc.) and should hold an honours level degree. The scholarship is valued at \$20,000 p.a. for 3 years (tax free) with additional funding available for research costs.
