Testing and Tagging of Electrical Appliances

THIS IS IMPORTANT!

All residents are advised that a contractor from Sherlock Safety will be testing and tagging ALL electrical items in your College room. This includes items belonging to both you and the University. It is a requirement under University policy that all electrical items in the Student Residences are tested and tagged annually to ensure it is safe for use..

The testing and tagging will take place Monday 22nd March. In the event any item fails the safety test, a **RED** Danger Tag (**DO NOT USE**) will be placed on the item. If the item is a University supplied item (like a fan or desk lamp), it will be the Residences responsibility to rectify the problem. If it is your personal item, it will be your responsibility to rectify the fault.

The cost of carrying out the testing will be met by the University.
